**PASADENA, CA (March 7, 2023)** Kidspace Children's Museum will join Pasadena's most prominent cultural institutions for ArtNight, a free evening of art, music, and play on March 10, 2023, from 6:00 pm to 10:00 pm.

As part of an ongoing partnership with Transformative Arts, Kidspace will host Mexican-Lebanese artist Georgina Reskala, whose practice features textile-based works inspired by her Mexico City and Los Angeles arts communities. Guests are invited to join Georgina in exploring traditional embroidery and yarn-wrapping art forms used by indigenous communities all over the world.

Appropriately, ArtNight marks the debut of the newest Kidspace exhibit, *Los Trompos*, an interactive art installation designed as a large-scale interpretation of vintage toy tops. Hop inside these vividly colored structures

to take a spin! The *Los Trompos* installation was designed by Esrawe + Cadena and first commissioned by the High Museum of Art in Atlanta.

Sing along with the all-female mariachi group *Las Colibrí* and their unique interpretation of traditional sones, huapangos, and rancheras.
